

Connecting Via Extranet to The University of Findlay using MAC OS X w/Nortel Client

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1. After purchasing and installing the Nortel VPN client, start the program and you should see the following icon on your desktop. Double-click on the icon to open the program.



2. Click on the **New** button to create a new connection.
