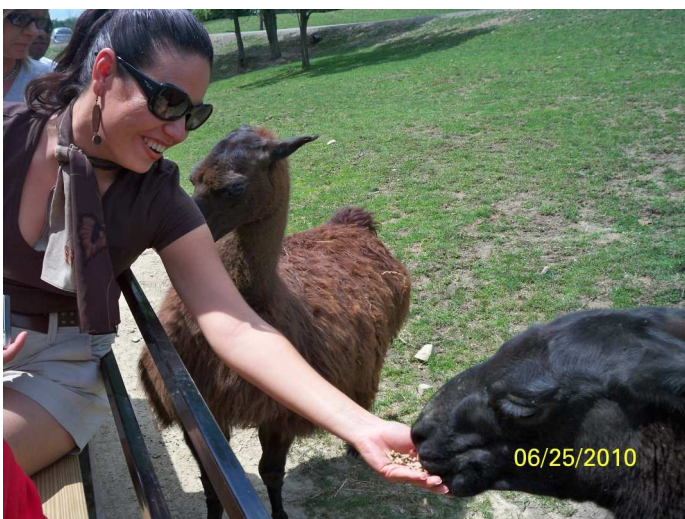


IBS Visits UF

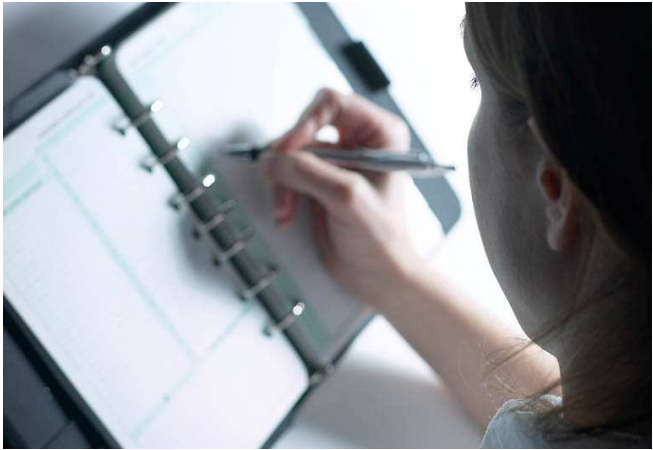
