

The University of Findlay Rider for Campus Performances
(the conditions in this Rider take precedence over all other contracts and riders)

The University of Findlay is affiliated with the Churches of God, and it acknowledges, preserves, and honors its Judeo-Christian heritage. Therefore, events that occur on campus must conform to the following guidelines:

1. The content of any performance must adhere to MPAA PG-13 standards. Any content that would exceed a MPAA PG-13 rating is not permitted. This means that content can not include crude, indecent, or strong coarse language/gestures; comments/actions that denigrate a particular group of people; intense sexual innuendo/situations; or intense/graphic violence.
2. If payment for a performance is required, the total agreed upon price will be paid at the conclusion of the performance once University representatives verify that all conditions of the contract and the University Rider have been followed. If the negotiated contract or University Rider is deemed violated by the University, the University reserves the right to withhold payment at the conclusion of the performance.
3. The presence of alcohol and/or illegal drugs is not permitted on campus at any time, and all applicable local, state, and federal statutes must be observed. The University may cancel the contract and performance without liability in the event a violation of regulations or statutes occurs. In the event of a cancellation due to a violation, the University shall be reimbursed by the performer/s for all expenses including services, facilities, and equipment, upon presentation of a statement of such expenses.
4. If any damage is caused by the performer/s and/or their staff to the facility or equipment, the performer/s will be responsible for the payment of the cost of any repairs or replacement required.
5. If the place of performance is destroyed or rendered unsuitable for the performance on the time and date specified, it is agreed that neither of the parties to the agreement will be held responsible for damages for reasons of postponement or cancellation of the performance.
6. Both parties to this agreement hereby agree to binding arbitration (at a neutral site) to resolve any legal disputes or financial accounting between themselves, according to the rules promulgated by the American Arbitration Association.
7. The overall contractual relationship of the parties is subject to interpretation based on “reasonable person standards”.

Main, Findlay, OH 45840. **If the University Rider is not signed and returned at least four weeks prior to the scheduled performance, the University reserves the right to cancel the event without liability, and any/all contract/s will be considered null and void.**
